RISE UP LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (PHASE II)

1. Context and Rationale:

This project is the result of the collaboration between the KENZ Foundation and IEI, designed to empower university leaders through a multi-phase training program. The first phase provided a strong theoretical foundation, equipping students with essential leadership concepts. Now, in this second phase, we are integrating theory with practical application, offering a more interactive and hands-on learning experience. The third phase will take this further with an intensive bootcamp focused on real-world challenges, allowing participants to put their knowledge into action. Additionally, follow-up initiatives will be implemented to track the progress of participants' projects, laying the groundwork for a fourth phase dedicated to further development and impact measurement.

2. Project Objectives:

- Strengthen the leadership skills of a select group of university leaders.
- Provide training in key areas such as career mapping, goal setting, communication, marketing, emotional intelligence, gender equality, and leadership.
- Create a group of ambassadors who can extend the learning to their universities, communities, and lead initiatives within the RiseUp Leadership platform.
- Encourage youth to become innovators of solutions rather than bystanders by thinking globally and acting locally.
- Provide participants with a Certificate of Attendance.

3. The next generation leaders:

The program will initially target a group of 29 young leaders—both men and women—from IEI's partner universities. While the group includes participants of both genders, the majority are women and girls, reflecting the program's focus on empowering female leadership.

This educational program brings together IEI and the KENZ Foundation, combining their expertise to contribute to the success of the RISE UP Leadership Program. Through this collaboration, KENZ Foundation provides additional knowledge and resources to these young Tanzanian leaders, ensuring they are equipped with the best tools to successfully tackle the challenges they have been assigned.

What is the RISE UP Leadership Program?

The RISE UP Leadership Program is a comprehensive initiative focused on developing youth leadership across 10 universities in Tanzania. IEI has established youth platforms in these institutions, each led by 3-4 trained leaders who actively manage these platforms with IEI's guidance and support.

These leaders receive specialized training in leadership, innovation, and digital skills, equipping them to develop solutions that create positive impacts within their communities.

In addition, IEI places these youth in volunteering roles within its own initiatives and across other sectors, such as health, to help bridge the skills gap and provide valuable real-world experience.

Neither an organization's leadership nor its strategies are spared in today's VUCA world. An acronym, coming from theleadership theories of Warren Bennis and Burt Nanus in 1987, with its phenomena of Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity, and Ambiguity puts long term experiences, dogmas and paradigms under scrutiny.

Managers and leaders facing these VUCA challenges need to guide by purpose to generate alignment and commitment. It takes a brief understanding of the psycho-logic of human behaviour and the willingness to develop empathy to create true collaboration and empower innovation. Conditions of a VUCA world require to anticipate the future and think backwards. The aim is to catalyse resources into meaningful activities and value-adding approaches and solutions.

Main topics of the impulses:

- ➤ Insights What is VUCA?
- ➤ Analysis What does VUCA mean for your organization and leadership?
- Solutions How to substitute the phenomena of Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity and Ambiguity with Vision, Understanding, Clarity, Agility and Adaptability to navigate a way to survive and thrive in the VUCA world
- ➤ Conclusions first answers for a roadmap/action plan to cope with the chaos and turbulence under VUCA conditions
